

MYOB Advanced: Creating a pivot table on a generic inquiry

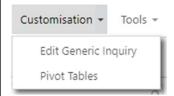
Overview

Functionality is available within generic inquiries to create a pivot table within the screen. In the example shown the pivot table will be based on the balance by Country.

To complete you will need to ensure that you have the roles for an Administrator and Customiser.

Step 1 – Ensure that the data is available to pivot

Select the Generic inquiry required. To be able to perform this function in the top left-hand corner will be the word "Customisation" with a drop-down box that reads "Edit Generic Inquiry" and "Pivot Tables".

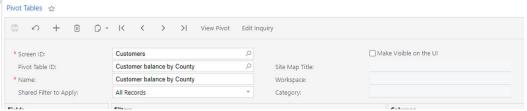


Ensure that the columns that you wish to pivot on are available. If not, then add the columns.

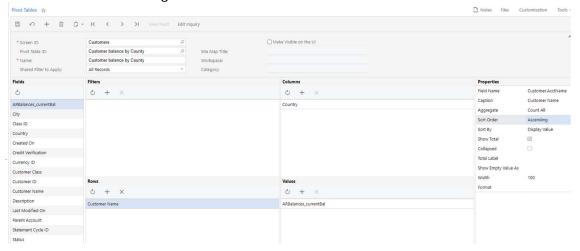
Once the data is available, click on "Pivot Table".

Step 2 – Create a pivot

1. In "Name" enter a name for the pivot table.



2. Select the Fields and drag to the filters into the form:



Click on save once any changes have been made and click on the "View Pivot" tab.



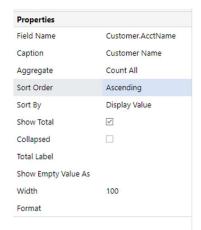
Step 3 – Modify a report

The Fields = are the fields visible to add to the pivot and replicate the columns in the generic inquiry.



The Filter, Columns, Rows and Values all work in the same way as Excel.

The Properties can be changed to show the data differently e.g. the value as a % or a value and if the total is shown.



In the header the form can be made into a separate screen by clicking on the "Make Visible on the UI".

Once ticked, the fields underneath will become available, and the screen placement can be defined.
